The CUPE Saskatchewan canoe trip coincides with the Back to Batoche celebrations of the Métis Nation in Saskatchewan.

During this annual voyage, participants navigate the waters of the South Saskatchewan River by canoe beginning at Clarkboro Ferry crossing (formerly Warman Ferry crossing) and arriving at the historic Métis community of Batoche, Saskatchewan—learning about Aboriginal culture, history and traditions along the way.

After the canoe trip, participants are encouraged to attend the Back to Batoche festivities that run July 17 - 20, 2014.

Canoe from Hague to Gabriel Dumont Bridge (4 hrs)

Canoe from Gabriel Dumont Bridge to Batoche (2 hrs)
