WOODROW STANLEY LLOYD AWARD FOR COLLECTIVE ACTION

The unsung hero, Woodrow Stanley Lloyd succeeded Tommy Douglas as Premier of Saskatchewan and went on to implement the first public health care program in Canada and North America, known as Medicare in 1962. Despite opposition from other political parties and many private doctors who withdrew their services, Lloyd's commitment to health care based on need, not the ability to pay, and to resolving the dispute built a public health care system we cherish and fight to defend today.

Just like W.S. Lloyd and the many people who stood beside him in the effort to achieve Medicare, there are many in our Union who deserve recognition for their leadership and activism.

The Woodrow Stanley Lloyd Award for Collective Action

is awarded annually by CUPE Saskatchewan to a group (such as a CUPE Local Union, a committee or group of outstanding individuals) responsible for a remarkable achievement, a tremendous contribution or exceptional activism. The award is presented each year at Convention.
