Give the gift of a fresh start by donating your old cell phones and cell phone accessories for recycling through the SaskTel Phones for a Fresh Start (PFFS) program.

Donating is easy. Cell phones, batteries, and accessories can be dropped off at any <u>SaskTel</u> <u>Store or one of over 50 participating Authorized Dealer locations</u> across the province.

Before you drop your phone off, be sure to deactivate it and remove all your personal info like contacts, phone numbers, photos, and SIM cards. Once donated, it can't be reclaimed.

## **About Phones for a Fresh Start**

SaskTel collects and recycles old cell phones and cell phone accessories and uses the proceeds generated by the recycling process to purchase new cell phones and prepaid phone cards. Watch the video to learn more.

The new cell phones and prepaid phone cards are then donated to Provincial Association of Transition Houses and Services of Saskatchewan's (PATHS) 24 member agencies to help people escaping



domestic violence. SaskTel also donates cell phones and prepaid phone cards to the Ministry of Social Services to support youth as they set out on the path to independence.

The SaskTel Phones for a Fresh Start program is partially funded by the proceeds of recycled devices donated through the program. SaskTel contributes the remaining funds.
