Henley to serve on WCB, not seeking re-election

Dear comrades and friends,

I have had the great privilege to represent CUPE Saskatchewan as President for the past four years and for over twenty years as the Secretary-Treasurer. Your support throughout has been humbling.

Effective soon, I will be taking on another role representing workers and leaving CUPE Saskatchewan.

The Saskatchewan Federation of Labour submitted my name to serve as the worker representative board member of the Workers' Compensation Board (WCB). The board position is a provincial government appointment by Order in Council that has just been approved on February 28 with public notification on March 4. The WCB is an independent board that is legislated to administer Saskatchewan's no-fault workplace insurance system under The Workers' Compensation Act.

My new role as a full-time WCB board member will be effective soon.

Based on this honour to represent labour on the WCB, I am advising that I will not be offering my name for re-election as CUPE Saskatchewan President at the upcoming Annual Convention on March 13 – 15, 2024.

I look forward to seeing many of you at the convention to say goodbye. I will not be far away working with CUPE and all affiliates in my new role.
