

# STANDING COMMITTEE APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT

Appointments are made to CUPE Saskatchewan Division's Standing Committees in odd years and/or at any time to fill a vacant position. **Appointed members serve up to a maximum two (2) year term**, or shorter term of a specified length to fill a position resulting from a vacancy.

To be eligible for appointment, you must be a member in good standing of a local chartered by CUPE and affiliated to CUPE Saskatchewan. Consideration will be given to members who were delegates at the most recent Annual Convention. Members may only sit on one (1) committee at any given time.

Standing Committees are governed by the CUPE Saskatchewan Division Constitution (Appendix "C") and work on a specific policy/program area as well as advise the Executive Board on actions to consider on behalf of CUPE members.
