



Candidates' Forum

The Candidates' Forum is optional, and participation will not have a bearing on a nominee's eligibility for election. The forum will be held in the afternoon on Wednesday, March 4.

Individuals do not need to be nominated in order to speak at the Candidates' Forum. Nominations for positions will take place at the election period indicated on the agenda.

In order to speak at the Candidates' Forum, you must sign-up at the Convention Office before the deadline indicated on the agenda: By 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 4, 2020.

The Candidates' Forum held during the Annual Convention of CUPE Saskatchewan is an opportunity to hear from delegates who wish to run for the positions of:

- President
- Secretary-Treasurer
- Nominee for CUPE National Regional Vice-President (to fill a vacancy)
- Trustee
- SFI Vice-President Nominees (and Alternates)

If you are intending to run as a candidate for a representative position on the Executive Board, these elections are held in their respective caucuses.

If you are intending to run as a candidate for membership on a standing committee, there is no opportunity to speak to the full Convention Floor.

RULES OF CANDIDATES' FORUM:

- The Candidates' Forum will be moderated.
- Each participant will have only up to four (4) minutes to speak. Speeches will be timed.
- No questions from the floor will be recognized.
- The order of the speakers for each position will be determined by drawing numbers.
